## Important Notice concerning The State Exams

As we approach the State exams I wish to bring some important procedural points concerning the school and exam timetable to your attention.

1. All exam students will be expected to wear the **FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM** for the duration of the exams. **Any student who violates this rule will be issued a replacement uniform** in the morning/afternoon before the exam begins.
2. As is different from a normal school day, students are allowed downtown for their lunch. **However any student who engages in anti-social or unacceptable behaviour there will have this privilege removed and will remain in the school for the entire lunchtime until their exams end.** Equally, I ask students to be conscious of litter while downtown. Any excess littering may again mean the privilege of going downtown being removed for all students.
3. Students who drive to school will be expected to hand in their car keys to the Deputy Principal's office as normal. Under no circumstances will students drive down the village for lunch – they may walk instead.
4. The Junior Certificate Timetable for June is enclosed. Leaving Cert students have already received their timetable. The buses operate according to the Leaving Cert. timetable and on most days, Leaving Cert. exams run until 5pm. On certain days Junior Cert students may be finished 1-1½ hours earlier than the Leaving Certificate students and well before the buses depart. **On the days marked with an (\*) I earnestly request you to collect or arrange for the collection of your son/daughter.** On these days he/she may have to wait a long period of time before a bus will transport them home. In the past some pupils have become involved in anti-social behaviour downtown because they simply had too much time on their hands.

I give the following day as an example – On Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> of June Junior Certs finish their exams for the day at 3:30pm. However the buses will not depart until 5:20pm. It is recommended that students who do not have any exam in the afternoon are collected after their morning exam and taken home.

Equally, **if students do not have an exam in the morning then they should not travel to school on the bus as they will be simply “hanging around” for several hours.** An example of this is Junior Cert French on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> June – that exam begins at 1.30.

5. On certain days lunchtime will last from 12pm-2pm. Students will be free to go home for lunch should you be in a position to collect them at this time.
6. Junior Cert. Students are advised that Book Rental Scheme books **MUST** be returned on the day the subject is completed. These books will be collected in the P.E. hall.

Finally could you please emphasise to your son/daughter the importance of not leaving the Exam Centre early. They have spent the last number of years preparing for this exam and are strongly advised to remain to the very end of the designated time.

**Parents/Guardians of any students who leave the examination centre early may be contacted by the school authorities by phone or text message, indicating the time the student left the exam centre. In addition they may be moved to the main school building where they will be supervised in a study environment.**

I trust you will be in a position to comply with the above requests and I take the opportunity to wish your son/daughter success in their forthcoming exams.
